

# ALEJANDRO SANZ RECEIVES STANDING OVATION AT THE 10th ANUAL LATIN GRAMMY AWARDS

**THIS WAS THE FIRST TIME THE 17X GRAMMY WINNER PERFORMED LIVE WITH ALICIA KEYS HIS HIT SONG "LOOKING FOR PARADISE"**

Las Vegas, NV (November 5th, 2009).- The city of Las Vegas hosted tonight the 10th Annual Latin Grammy Awards, a ceremony filled with touching moments which were all captured worldwide through Univision network and for the first time, via the internet online through the official website [www.latingrammy.com](http://www.latingrammy.com).

One of the most celebrated moments of the night was when Spanish star Alejandro Sanz took the stage to perform live for the first time with Alicia Keys his hit song "Looking For Paradise". The two performers, accompanied by the spectacular band led by Mike Ciro, captivated the audience with his performance in which he conveyed the magic and positive energy that follows this song. Alejandro also performed his song "Y Sólo Se Me Ocurre Amarte" (2002 Grammy winner for "Best Song") which had been previously chosen by Univision online subscribers to be performed at the gala.

Alejandro was also responsible for presenting the most coveted prize of the night, "Record Of The Year" with actress Eva Longoria, which was granted to Calle 13.

Alejandro Sanz is a very important part of the Latin Grammy history being one of the artists who has received the highest number of awards with a total of 15 Latin Grammy plus two American Grammy. In the words of Gabriel Abaroa, Latin Recording President "Alejandro Sanz is a very significant representation of these ten years of the organization. There are artists who have seen their development along with the Academy and Alejandro is one of them. "

His new album "Paraiso Express" goes on sale worldwide on November 10th and its first single "Looking For Paradise" remains in the top position on Billboard's Latin Pop chart in addition to being No. 1 in Spain, Mexico, Argentina and Chile.
