

# ALEJANDRO SANZ'S UPCOMING EIGHT CONCERTS IN MADRID, SPAIN SOLD OUT IN ONE HOUR!

**THE TICKETS TO ATTEND THE WORLDWIDE RELEASE OF SANZ'S NEW ALBUM  
"PARAISO EXPRESS" AT THE COMPAC GRAN VIA THEATRE, WERE RELEASED AT 10AM  
THIS MORNING AND IN ONE HOUR WERE COMPLETELY SOLD OUT**

The anticipation is high! Alejandro Sanz announced less than a month ago that he would perform eight exclusive and intimate concerts at the Compac Gran Via Theatre in Madrid, Spain, on November 25, 26, 27, 29 and December 1, 2, 4 and 6.

This is the first time that the 17x Grammy winner will perform in a venue of this capacity (1,000 seats), all with the idea to be closer to his fans that have supported his career from the beginning.

Fans were so excited to see Sanz, who is releasing his eighth album "Paraiso Express" on November 10th, that as soon as the sale started they rushed to the site and in only one hour, tickets for all eight shows were gone.

This is only the start of a busy agenda for the Spanish singer songwriter. For the last weeks he has been blogging on his official website ([www.alejandrosanz.com](http://www.alejandrosanz.com)), about all the promo activities he has been doing since August, releasing his brand new video "Looking For Paradise", the first single of his album and a duet with Alicia Keys, his social work, his performance at the MTV Latin America 2009 and more.

On November 5th, Sanz will perform "Looking For Paradise" at the Latin Grammy ceremony to air on Univision and in 2010 he will embark his worldwide tour where he will perform his hits as well as the new songs from the anticipated album "Paraiso Express".
