

## **BURT BACHARACH AT A GLANCE**

Legendary composer Burt Bacharach has helped define the music of the 20th and 21st centuries. His music is as diverse as his audiences, spanning generations and continents, as he is celebrated both as a pop culture icon and one of the world's greatest contemporary composers.

Bacharach's credits read like the world's favorite radio station's playlist: %Alfie,+ %Arthur's Theme (Best That You Can Do),+ %Close To You,+ %Do You Know The Way To San Jose,+ %Say A Little Prayer,+ %I'll Never Fall In Love Again,+ %This Guy's In Love With You,+ %Walk On By,+ %What The World Needs Now Is Love,+ and %Wishin' And Hopin'+ are among just the 48 Top 10 hits, nine #1 songs.

Bracketed with contemporaries Bob Dylan, Lennon and McCartney and Paul Simon, and recognized with three Academy Awards and eight Grammys, Bacharach's music is embedded in the culture. He was inducted into the Songwriters Hall of Fame, and is the recipient of other tributes received from top music industry institutions to governments, universities and charitable and philanthropic groups. From helping charitable organizations raise funds (%That's What Friends Are For+), to Broadway (%Promises, Promises+), movies (%Raindrops Keep Falling on My Head,+ %The Look of Love+) to scores of new recordings of his songs each year, Bacharach's music is always nearby.

His latest CD is *Burt Bacharach Live at the Sydney Opera House with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra*, which charted internationally upon its release. Like everything in Burt's life, it answers the question, %What's it all about?+ The answer is, It's the music.
