## MARC SALEM

**Professor Marc Salem has been a student of the human mind for over 30 years.**

**Born in Philadelphia, the son of a rabbi and pharmacist, Salem's interest in the mind and its workings goes back to his childhood experiences. At a young age, Salem set out to discover and uncover the mysteries of the mind, from influencing otherwise random choices of friends and family to anticipating events before they occurred.**

**As an academic, Professor Salem holds advanced degrees from both the University of Pennsylvania and New York University. His work with Ray Birdwhistle, the founder of kinesics (also known as body language), has been seminal to Birdwhistle's practice. Professor Salem has been on faculty of several major universities, consulted influential law firms and law enforcement agencies, and continues to seek understanding of how the mind creates reality and meaning.**

**As a researcher, Professor Salem has traveled the globe exploring the mind and its potential. He was a director of research at CHILDREN'S TELEVISION WORKSHOP, studying the development and nature of the mental process.**

**As an entertainer, Professor Salem has performed his program around the world. He has just completed a year-long world tour performing to sold out audiences, astounding and entertaining millions. His theatrical show, MIND GAMES, concluded two extended runs off-Broadway to both critical and popular acclaim. Salem has been featured on *The Rosie O'Donnell Show*, *The Montel Williams Show*, *Maury*, CNN and dozens of others. His one-man network TV special, *Marc Salem's Mysterious Mind* aired this past year.**

**Games**, this new production features Vibrations, an all female, world-class Jazz trio. Vibrations provide interstitial music to open and close the show as well as interacting throughout with Salem. Professor Salem believes the goal of this program is the synthesis of a new style of entertainment. The jazz idiom has traditionally featured improvisation and the exploration of new tonalities, pitch, silences, harmonies and rhythmic interplay; musicians and ensemble "taking chances" with the material. In this same spirit, Marc will, "walk the tightrope" every night. The inclusion of a live combo introduces not just another dimension of entertainment, but another level of risk and spontaneity.

Performances will be presented in the evenings on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday with two shows scheduled on Friday and Saturday nights. Marc Salem's show of mind reading and Music a noteworthy departure from the usual presentations here. Salem's engagement at Feinstein's is a tribute to his success off-Broadway and in television appearances, as well as to his talent and showmanship.
